RULES and DEADLINES

- 1. Students must submit in PDF form 1 copy of the original work typed in 12-point Times New Roman font. Work should be sent to: ecaamuseum@gmail.com BEFORE Monday, January 3, 2022 @ 5:00pm. No exceptions! The cover page should include the student's name, school attending, grade level, parents name, email address, and telephone number. Students will receive a parental consent form once speech has been submitted.
- 2. Essay must have a minimum of words based on the grade level (see below).
- 3. Essay must be the student's original work.
- 4. Students will be judged on speaking, oratory delivery, presentation, and appearance.
- 5. Three contest division categories:

Elementary grades 3rd-5th (250 word minimum), Secondary grades 6th-8th (500 word minimum) and High School 9th-12 (1000) word minimum).
